



FNSB Oil To Gas Conversion Program

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ARPA Funds: \$1MM+\$1.3MM

The FNSB Assembly added \$1MM to the Oil to Gas Conversion Program our of the ARPA funds at the beginning of 2022. An additional \$1.3MM from the same funding source was added in August, 2022.

Targeted Airshed Grant

The Borough was awarded the grant and \$3.2MM of it will go toward grants to residents and businesses. The funds have to go through different departments at the state and local level. The Air Quality office expects to be able to approve applicants in October. Applications are currently being accepted and waitlisted.

State of Alaska Capital Funding

The State of Alaska allocated \$1.25MM from the capital budget to the program. The Air Quality office anticipates being able to make funding available to residents from this fund in conjunction with the Targeted Airshed Grant.

Conversion Financing

What?

IGU asked local lenders to come up with loan programs that could help cutomers cover the expenses of a oil to natural gas conversion.

Who?

Three local lenders jumped on that opportunity: MAC Federal Credit Union, Northrim Bank, and Mt. McKinley Bank.

How?

All programs that were developed use home equity to secure the loans. They have varying terms and qualifiers, but are all designed with natural gas conversions in mind.









Other updates

HB307

HB 307 is a bill designed to extend AIDEA's authorization to finance and issue bonds targeting the Interior Energy Project (IEP). It was signed by the governor on July 8, 2022.



Cook Inlet Gas

In April, Hilcorp opened a conversation about the gas supply in the Cook Inlet. They notified utilities that they should not rely on Hilcorp for natural gas supply past their existing contracts. IGU has a contract until 2032 and is actively working on options beyond that timeline.



Heating Oil Prices

Delivered heating oil is 68% more expensive than natural gas as of 8/31/2022.





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
