


WHAT HAPPENED IN FY19

- CONOCO BEGAN PRODUCING WEST SAK OIL FROM THE 1H PAD
- GMT1 ENTERED PRODUCTION, DRILLING CONTINUES
- GMT2 COMPLETED PERMITTING AND WAS SANCTIONED
- WILLOW RECEIVED DRAFT EIS
- MOOSE PAD WAS COMPLETED AND IS NOW PRODUCING
- LIBERTY RECEIVED RECORD OF DECISION (SANCTION DECISION IMMINENT)
- PIKKA RECEIVED ROD, NEW FIRST OIL TARGET OF 2022
- AK LNG PERMITTING PROGRESSED, BUT OUTLOOK IS PESSIMISTIC
- ANWR LEASE SALE FINAL EIS WAS ISSUED, ROD IMMINENT TARGETING DECEMBER SALE



















FY20 OIL INDUSTRY JOBS PROJECTION
