- 4,700 direct and 9,600 direct and indirect jobs attributed to Alaska's mining industry
- Average wage of \$115,000; twice the state average
- Year-round jobs for over 90 Alaska communities
- \$175 million to Alaska Native Corporations
- \$880 million in purchases of good and services to 600 Alaska vendors
- \$166 million in taxes to local & state governments
